





Sanskriti...The school also organized the activity in school. Scholars wrote on the topics provided to them.



कक्षा- M1 से ड3 में 'श्रव्या' गतिविधि के द्वारा साक्षात्कार विधा से परिचित करवाया गया।




कक्षा— J4 पक्षियों पर अद्भुत बातें




